Subject: Protected Bike Lanes on Rainnie Drive		
Motion for Transportation Standing Committee to Consider:		
That the Transportation Standing Committee recommend that Regional Council request a staff report regarding the protected bike lanes on Rainnie Drive that addresses the issue of cars consistently parking in the buffer zone in the bike lanes.		
Reason:		
Since the Rainnie Drive protected bike was installed, cars parked in the buffer zone and in the bike lanes has been a consistent problem and safety concern for cyclists. The closer cars are to the bicycles travelling in the bike lane, the higher chance of safety issues arising.		
Outcome Sought:		
A staff report that provides a recommendation on how to address this parking problem and find ways to prevent cars from consistently parking in the buffer zone and bike lanes.
