Subject: Participation of the Chain of Lakes Trail in the Rum Runner Trail						
Motion for Transportation Standing Committee to Consider:						
That the Transportation Standing Committee recommend that Regional Council request a staff report regarding the participation of the Chain of Lakes Trail in the Rum Runners Trail.						
Reason:						
The current user license that the Chain of Lakes Trail Association (COLTA) has with Halifax does not provide COLTA with the authority to enter into an agreement or partnership of this nature. Unlike most other trails, the Chain of Lakes Trail is on Halifax land and has been maintained by Halifax. Under the current license agreement, COLTA only has the authority over infrastructure placed on the trail and some maintenance.						
Outcome Sought:						
A staff report that provides a recommendation on the Chain of Lakes Trail becoming part of the Rum Runners Trail, which is an association of all the trails from Halifax to Lunenberg (except Chain of Lakes) that promotes cycling tourism.
