Subject: Roles and Responsibilities of Community Associations re: Active Transportation Facilities		
Motion for Transportation Standing Committee to Consider:		
<p>That the Transportation Standing Committee request a staff report regarding the future roles and responsibilities of community associations with respect to the construction, maintenance and operation of active transportation facilities in Halifax and with respect to the relationship of such community associations with the municipality.</p>		
Reason:		
<p>There are different relationships that Halifax has with community groups that run or oversee active transportation assets, such as Trails. As an example, some trail associations operate on provincial land, some operate on municipal land. All the associations have similar user agreements based on one model developed for associations operating on provincial land, however, with differing dynamics, different types of relationships are likely necessary.</p>		
Outcome Sought:		
<p>A staff report that provides a recommendation on the appropriate relationship for each type of community association on active transportation facilities.</p>
