<b>Motion for Council to Consider:</b> Request a staff report to consider the implementation of a 'science advisor' position on staff to advise council on science issues. It should answer issues related to what the requirements of such a position might be, the type of person(s), (qualifications, area of expertise etc.), association with outside institutes, remuneration, and whether it is a full time or part time position.						
<b>Reason:</b> Councillors are expected to make decisions that often require trying to make sense of the sciences from the point of extremes and absurdities. And the decisions that Council make can have lasting impacts on the municipality.
