## HRM Policing Services Environmental Scan 2nd Quarter 2017



### Total HRM Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences reported in the second quarter of 2017 show an **increase** of +188 reported offences or +3.68% compared to the second quarter of 2016. Drugs for second quarter 2017 show a **decrease** of -19 offences or -6.27% compared to second quarter 2016.

Property offences account for **45%** of the reported Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for **15%** and Criminal Other offences account for **40%**.

### Property Crimes

Property crime shows a **decrease** of -175 reported offences or -6.79%.

Stolen motor vehicles **decreased** by -17 offences or -17.35%.

Break and Enters **decreased** by -33 offences or -13.36%.

Frauds **decreased** by -20 offences or -5.75%.

### Violent Crimes

Violent crime has experienced an **increase** in the second quarter of 2017 compared to 2016 by +107 offences or a change of +16.14%.

Robberies **increased** by +10 offences or a change of +28.57%.

Homicides remained the same at 3 incidents in 2017 compared to the second quarter of 2016.

Attempted murders **increased** by +2 offences in the second quarter of 2017 or a change of +33.33%.

Assaults **increased** by +94 offences or a change of +15.46%. Assaults accounted for 91% of violent crimes in the second quarter of 2017.

### Criminal Other

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc.) has **increased** by +256 or +13.72%.

Prostitution offences **decreased** by -15 offences in the second quarter of 2017 over 2015 or -83.33%.

Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.
