

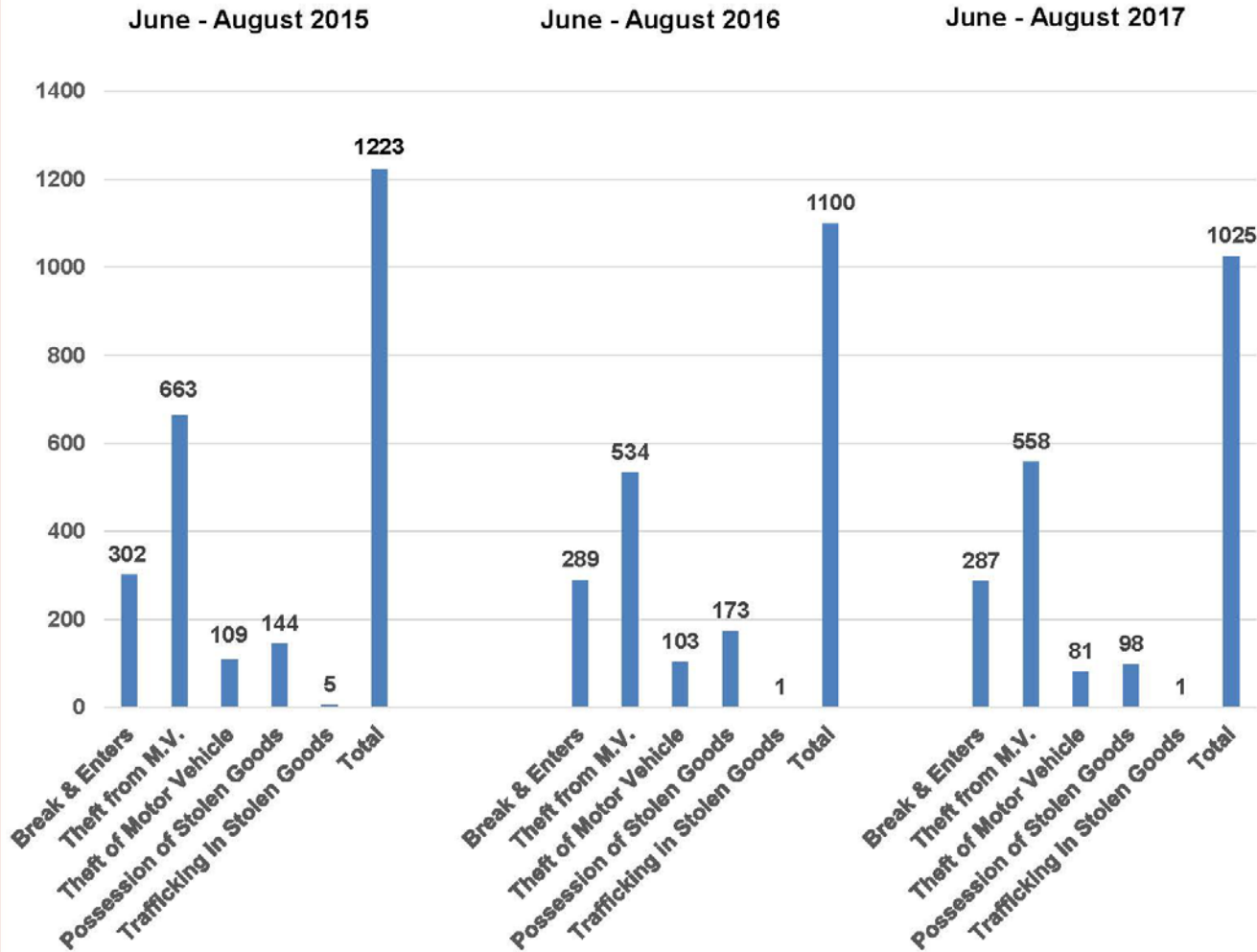

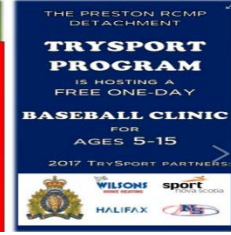
HRM Policing - Property Crime



In the summer the general public are more inclined to leave windows open/doors unlocked during the warmer weather. From June to August, Halifax Regional Municipality (HRM) experienced a -7% decrease overall during that period in 2017 when compared to the same in 2016 and a -16% decrease when compared to 2015. Break & Enters decreased by -1% in 2017 when compared to 2016, Theft from Motor Vehicles increased by +4%, Theft of Motor Vehicles decreased by -21% and Possession of Stolen Goods decreased by -43%.

Baseball, youth and policing – a 'positive' mix



**Home Run!** Hfx. District RCMP hit it out of the park this year by hosting a one-day TrySport baseball clinic for youth August 15<sup>th</sup>. In 2011, the Preston RCMP Detachment developed the TrySport Program and since then has exposed youth in the community to sports not traditionally played. **RCMP Depot** -A local youth from from Halifax District area was selected to participate with 28 other youth from across the country to train as an RCMP Recruit. This is the first time NS participated in the Depot Youth Camp as part of the Aboriginal Recruiting Strategy. Selection was based on a number of criteria including community and school involvement, leadership and an interest in law enforcement. **Hfx. ## Operation Fall-Back

Operation Fall-Back, now in its 13<sup>th</sup> year, runs throughout the month of September. Halifax Regional Police implements high-visibility patrols and directs enforcement in known complaint areas in the south end. Working closely with community groups, university officials and student representatives assists in the prevention of problems.

When Operation Fall-Back concludes a partnership with Dalhousie University evolves into Dalhousie Designated Police Patrol - a dedicated patrol program in designated neighbourhoods around Dalhousie and King’s campuses. HRP provides police cruisers and Dalhousie pays staffing costs for officers patrolling at peak times on selected dates throughout the year.



## Back to School Safety Tips

HRP launched its #backtoschoolsafety campaign on social media September 5. Tips for guardians and students were tweeted and posted throughout the first week of September. A video was also created, which featured Cst. Shawn Currie and six-year-old Aurora.
