ORIGIN

Motion of the Executive Standing Committee In Camera meeting held on March 20, 2017.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

By-law No. 1 of the Federation of Canadian Municipalities.

Administrative Order No. 1 - Schedule 6

The Executive Standing Committee shall act as the Membership Selection Committee of the Council with a mandate to function as the nomination committee for appointments to Boards and Committees, including at large nomination to Standing Committees, except as delegated to other Standing Committees by the Council.

RECOMMENDATION

The Executive Standing Committee recommends Halifax Regional Council:

1. Adopt the resolution required by the Federation of Canadian Municipalities in regard to the nomination of Councillor Walker as Council's nominee to the Board of FCM for a term to June 2018 as provided in Attachment 1 of this report.

BACKGROUND

The By-law No. 1 of the Federation of Canadian Municipalities specifies that, of the four (4) Directors representing Nova Scotia on the Board of FCM, one (1) nominee selected by its Affiliate Member (Union of Nova Scotia Municipalities); one (1) nominee selected by Halifax Regional Municipality; and two (2) nominees selected by the Accredited Representatives of its Municipal Members.

In April 2016 Halifax Regional Council appointed Councillor Russell Walker as Council's representative to Federation of Canadian Municipalities for a term of two years from June 2016 to June 2018.

The By-laws of Federation of Canadian Municipalities require that Council pass a resolution to that effect annually in advance of the Election of the Board of Directors.

DISCUSSION

Attachment # 1 provides the resolution required for Councillor Walker to continue to stand for appointment at the Annual General meeting of the Federation of Canadian Municipalities as the representative of Halifax Regional Council.
