



Halifax Regional Police Environmental Scan 3rd Quarter 2017

Total HRP Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the third quarter of 2017 show an increase of +400 or +9.96% compared to the third quarter of 2016.

Drug Offences in the third quarter of 2017 decreased by -10 or by -5.49% compared to the third quarter of 2016.

In the third quarter Property offences count for 50% of the Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for 16% and Criminal Other offences account for 34%.

Third Quarter comparison between 2016 and 2017:

Property Crimes

Overall, Property Crime increase by +277 or +14.24%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles increased by +14 or +25.93%.

Break and Enters increased by +24 or +12.63%.

Frauds increased by +76 or +35.68%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent crime increased by +106 or +18.50%.

Robberies decreased by -8 or -15.09%.

Homicides increased by +2 incidents or +200%.

Attempted Murders increased by +1 or +100%.

Assaults increased by +108 or +21.22%.

Assaults accounted for 91% of reported violent crimes in the third quarter of 2017.

Criminal Other Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc)

Offensive Weapons decreased by -29 in the third quarter of 2017 or by -42.65%

Prostitution offences decreased by -1 offence in the third quarter of 2017 or -20%

Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.





**Crimes Against Persons

2016-2017**






HRP 3rd Quarter Stats East

Assaults

Assaults Level 1 account for 62% of the total Assaults in the 3rd quarter of 2017 compared to 62% in 2016 and experienced a 22% increase in 2017 over the same period last year.

Assaults with a Weapon Causing Bodily Harm accounted for 16% of the total Assaults in 2017 compared to 15% in 2016 and experienced a 34% increase over the same period last year.

All forms of Sexual Assaults combined accounted for 16% of the total Assaults in 2017 compared to 16% in 2016 and experienced a 20% increase over the same period last year.

Robberies

Robberies accounted for 7% of the total Persons Crimes in the 3rd quarter of 2017 compared to 9% in 2016 and experienced a 15% decrease in 2017 over the same period last year.

Break & Enter

Break & Enter (Residence) accounted for 54% of the total Break & Enters in the 3rd quarter of 2017 compared to 54% in 2016 and experienced a 13% increase in 2017 over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Other) accounted for 19% of the total Break & Enters in the 3rd quarter of 2017 compared to 28% in 2016 and experienced a 38% increase in 2017 over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Business) accounted for 24% of the total Break & Enters in the 3rd quarter of 2017 compared to 29% in 2016 and experienced a -5% decrease in 2017 over the same period last year.

Theft/Possession Under \$5000

Theft – other under \$5000 accounted for 71% of the total Theft Under \$5000 in the 3rd quarter of 2017 compared to 71% in 2016 and experienced a 12% increase in 2017 over the same period last year.

Theft from Motor Vehicle accounted for 27% of the total Theft Under \$5000 in the 3rd quarter of 2017 compared to 26% in 2016 and experienced a 17% increase over the same period last year.

Possession of Stolen Goods experienced a -33% decrease in the 3rd quarter of 2017
