Each year members of the U.S. Personnel Exchange Program in collaboration with the U.S. Consulate General in Halifax host a Deadman's Island Remembrance Event on U.S. Memorial Day. This year's event will be held at Deadman's Island Park on 29 May 2017 at 1100 and will pay tribute to roughly 200 American soldiers and sailors who died in British captivity during the War of 1812.
