Subject: HRM's Neighbourhood and Special District Signage Policy		
Motion for Council to Consider:		
That Halifax Regional Council request a staff report to amend the Neighbourhood and Special District Signage Policy dated March 11, 2008 to include:		
Policy 1.5 Neighbourhood signs are permitted in the HRM street right-of-way.		
Reason:		
Residents from a number of neighbourhoods in District 10 (Fairview, Clayton Park, Rockingham, Birch Cove, Prince's Lodge and Kearney Lake) have expressed concern that their neighbourhood identity will be lost. The neighbourhood signs will allow the residents to demonstrate pride in their neighbourhood while reflecting local history.		
Outcome Sought:		
Council approval of inclusion of Policy 1.5 to allow for installation of neighbourhood signs in HRM street-of-way.
