Subject: District Capital Request		
Motion for Council to Consider: "That Halifax Regional Council approve a one-time exemption to grant a request for \$10,000.00 from the District 3 District Capital Fund for the supplies and labour to paint and repair the Fisherman's Cove Development Association Heritage Centre."		
Reason: The Fisherman's Cove Heritage Centre is run by the not-for-profit group, Fishermen's Cove Development Association, on land leased to them from the Department of Natural Resources. Section 4.3 of the District Capital policy outlines that the funds are "not normally" to be used on lands owned by the Crown. Funding has been provided in the past for the beautification of the area including painting of the various buildings along Government Wharf Road.		
Outcome Sought: Approval to provide \$10,000.00 in funding to the Fisherman's Cove Development Association for the supplies and labour to paint and repair the Heritage Centre in Fisherman's Cove, Government Wharf Road, Eastern Passage.
