



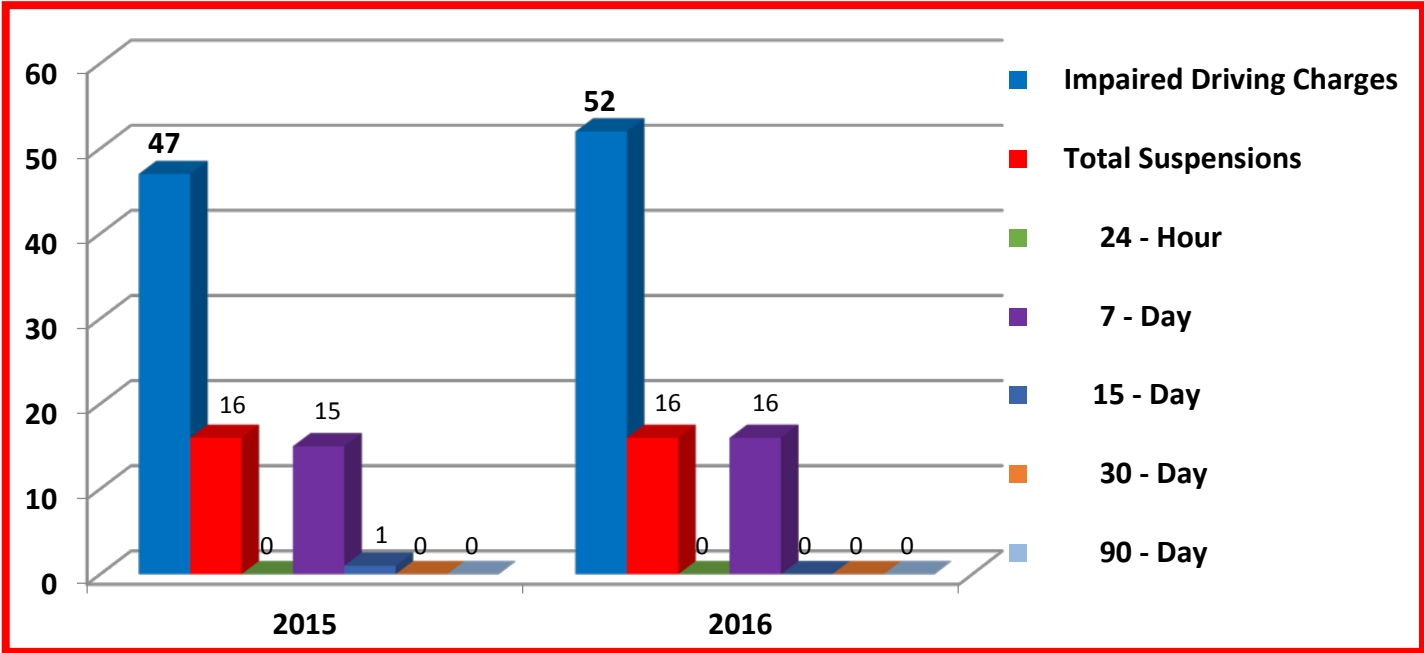

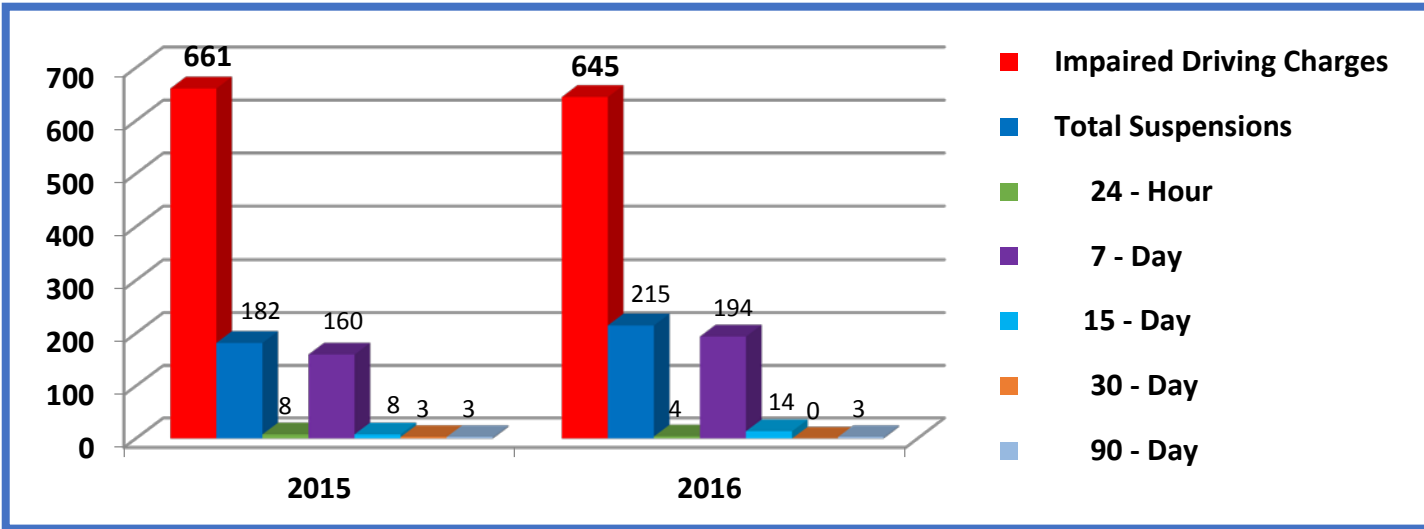
Summary

Impaired Driving - December

In December 2016, HRM police charged 52 individuals with impaired driving, a +11% increase in impaired driving charges over December 2015. Impaired driving suspensions compared to December 2015 remained the same at sixteen. HRM police identified 13 impaired drivers as a result of attending motor vehicle collisions. 38 impaired drivers were detected at traffic stops. For Suspensions, 8 drivers were identified by checkpoints, 7 through traffic stops, and one as a result of an accident.

Impaired Driving January - December

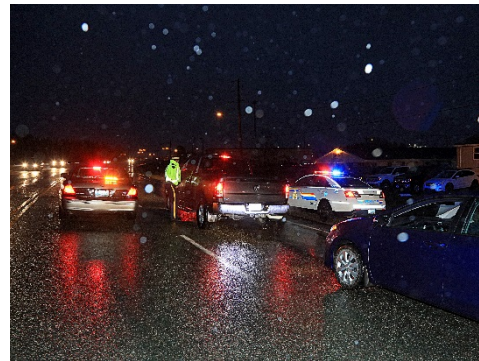
From Jan. 1st - Dec. 31st 2016, HRM police charged 645 individuals with impaired driving, a -2% decrease in impaired driving charges and a +18% increase in impaired driving suspensions when compared to the 2015 calendar year. 46 individuals were charged with impaired driving by drugs. 187 people charged were more than two times the legal limit, 36 people were more than three times the legal limit and 7 people were more than 4 times the legal limit of 80 mg. of alcohol per 100 ml. of blood.
