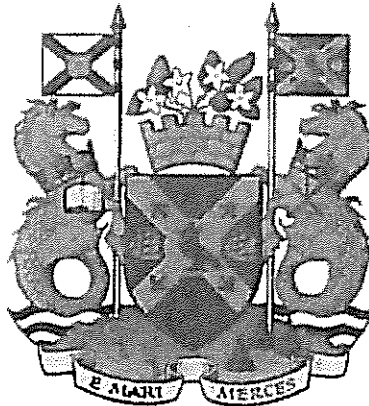

Red Tape Awareness Week January 22nd – 26th, 2018

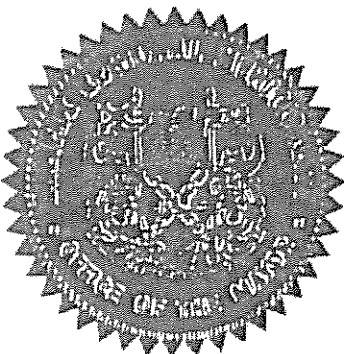
