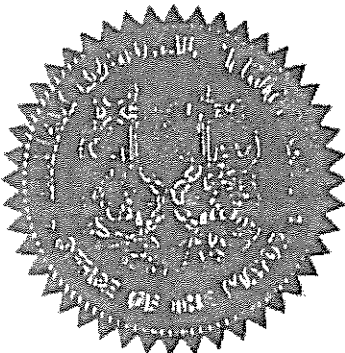
February 6, 1818, was the day Lord Dalhousie received approval to establish the University with Dalhousie's first campus located here at the site of City Hall; and
