2016-2017**




Crimes Against Property 4th Quarter Comparison




RCMP Halifax District 4th Quarter Stats Cole Harbour





HRM Policing Services Environmental Scan 4th Quarter 2017



Total HRM Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences reported in the fourth quarter of 2017 show an **increase** of **+1,034** reported offences or an **increase** of **+22.84%** compared to the fourth quarter of 2016. Drug offences in the fourth quarter of 2017 **increased** by **46** or **+20.72%** compared to the fourth quarter of 2016.

Property offences account for **49%** of the reported Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for **16%** and Criminal Other offences account for **35%**.

Property Crimes

Property crime shows an **increase** of **+416** reported offences or **+18.24%**.

Stolen motor vehicles **decreased** by **-6** offences or **-6.9%**.

Break and Enters **increased** by **+105** offences or **+38.89%**.

Frauds **decreased** by **-5** offences or **-1.85%**.

Violent Crimes

Violent crime experienced an **increase** in the fourth quarter of 2017 compared to 2016 by **+294?** offences or a change of **+48.12%**.

Robberies **increased** by **+14** offences or a change of **+29.17%**.

Homicides **decreased** by **-3** or **75%** in the fourth quarter in 2017 compared to the fourth quarter of 2016.

Attempted murders **increased** by **+4** or **+100%** in 2017 compared to the fourth quarter of 2016.

Assaults **increased** by **+272** offences or a change of **+49.91%**. Assaults accounted for **90%** of violent crimes in the fourth quarter of 2017.

Criminal Other

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc.) has **increased** by **+324** or **+19.8%**.

Prostitution offences **decreased** by **-5** offences in the fourth quarter of **2017** over **2016** or **-62.5%**.

Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.

Environmental Scan of 2017 4th Quarter

Total District Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the fourth quarter of 2017 show an **increase** of +222 or by +20.79% compared to the fourth quarter in 2016.

Drugs for the fourth quarter of 2017 **increased** by +12 or by +16.44% compared to the fourth quarter of 2016.

In the fourth quarter Property offences reported accounted for 44% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons accounted for 18% and Other Criminal Code offences accounted for 38%.

Fourth Quarter comparison between 2016 and 2017:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime **increased** by +19 or +3.49%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles remained the same at 29.

Break and Enters **increased** by +4 or +4.94%.

Frauds **decreased** by -14 or -18.18%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent Crime **increased** by +92 or +65.25%.

Robberies increased by +3 or +50%.

Homicides decreased by -1 or -100%.

Attempted Murders remained the same at 0.

Assaults **increased** by +87 or +67.44%.

Assaults accounted for 93% of reported violent crimes in the fourth quarter of 2017.

Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (i.e. arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting currency etc.)

Offensive Weapons **increased** by +7 in the fourth quarter of 2017 or +46.67%.

Moral offences remained the same at 0.

Environmental Scan of 2017 Calendar Year

Total District Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in 2017 show an **increase** of +182 or +3.98% compared to 2016.

Drugs for 2017 remained the same at 336 incidents.

In 2017 Property offences reported accounted for 43% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons accounted for 16% and Other Criminal Code offences accounted for 41%.
