- Eminent Methodist minister
- Descendent of a Loyalist who settled in Wallace in the 1770s
- Involved in the formation of the United Church
- Publisher of “The Weslyn”

Stephen Doane

- Purchased the home in 1912
- Joined the shipping company A.G. Jones and Company
- Served as an Embarkment Officer
- Appointed chairperson of the NS Board of Censors in 1943
- Participated in many other clubs and activities


