SUBJECT: Increase to Cost Sharing – Hammonds Plains Road Paving (Sandy

Academy Entrance to Smiths Road), Central Region

#### **ORIGIN**

The Approved 2017/18 Capital Budget.

#### **LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY**

Under the HRM Charter, Section 79 Halifax Regional Council may expend money for municipal purposes. The recommended contract award complies with all of the pre-requisites for awarding contracts as set out in section 34 of Administrative Order 2016-005-ADM, the Procurement Administrative Order.

Section 74(1) of the Halifax Regional Municipality Charter provides that "The Municipality may agree with one or more municipalities, villages, service commissions, the Government of the Province or of Canada or a department or agency of either of them or a band council pursuant to the Indian Act (Canada) to provide or administer municipal or village services.

Section 25.3 of the Administrative Order 2016-005-Adm, Procurement Administrative Order states A Sole Source Purchase may occur (m) for the procurement of Goods, Services, Construction or Facilities from a public body or a not-for-profit corporation.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that Halifax Regional Council approve a cost sharing increase of an estimated amount of \$79,258 (net HST included) to the Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal (NSTIR) with funding from Project Account No. CR000005 – Street Recapitalization, as outlined in the Financial Implications section of this report.

## **BACKGROUND**

On July 18, 2017, Halifax Regional Council approved cost sharing with NSTIR of \$208,572 (net HST included) for paving on Hammonds Plains Road from Sandy Academy Entrance to Smiths Road.

The proposed paving work is an integration project with proposed upgrades to existing Highway 102 Interchange project by NSTIR.

The proposed work was tendered by NSTIR as part of a Highway 102 Interchange roadworks project as outlined in Agreement 2017-007 Route 213 (Hammonds Plains Road) repaving. Both projects were tendered together as one construction contract.

The construction related to this work will be completed to Halifax Regional Municipality's standards.

#### **DISCUSSION**

As per section 6 of the cost share agreement 2017-007 Route 213 (Hammonds Plains Road) repaying, the Province is required to notify the Municipality in writing of any cost overruns of more than 10% on approved projects. The low bid tender amount is greater than NSTIR's estimated amount by more than 10%.

There are no Local Improvement charges associated with this work.

#### **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

Based on the accepted low bid the estimated increased cost to HRM is \$76,000 plus net HST of \$3,258 for a net total of \$79,258 (net HST included). Funding is available in the Approved 2017/18 Project Budget from Project Account No. CR000005 – Street Recapitalization. The budget availability has been confirmed by Finance.

The above costs include engineering, administration and quality assurance testing costs.

The cost sharing component is associated with paving and related reinstatement from Sandy Academy Entrance to Smiths Road. This is a UNIT PRICE contract and the cost will be dependent upon the actual quantities measured and approved by the HRM Project Manager.

# **RISK CONSIDERATION**

There are no significant risks associated with the recommendation in this Report. The risks considered rate low. To reach this conclusion, consideration was given to financial, legal and compliance, and service delivery risks.

# **LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY**

Section 74(1) of the *Halifax Regional Municipality Charter* provides that "The Municipality may agree with one or more municipalities, villages, <u>service commissions</u>, the Government of the Province or of Canada or a department or agency of either of them or a band council pursuant to the *Indian Act (Canada)* to provide or administer municipal or village services.

Section 79(1) of the Halifax Regional Municipality Charter provides that "The Council may expend money required by the Municipality for ... (aa) streets, culverts, retaining walls, sidewalks, curbs and gutters;"

## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that Halifax Regional Council authorize a sole source award and reimbursement of an amount up to \$208,572 (net HST included) to the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal, Nova Scotia (NSTIR) with funding from Project Account No. CR000005 – Street Recapitalization, as outlined in the Financial Implications section of this report.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Approved 2017/18 Project Budget includes funds for the Paving on Hammonds Plains Road from Sandy Academy Entrance to Smiths Road.

The proposed paving work is the integration project with proposed upgrades to existing Highway 102 Interchange project by NSTIR.

The proposed works will be completed in conjunction with the NSTIR Highway 102 Interchange project. Both projects will be tendered together as one construction contract. The construction related to this work will be completed to Halifax Regional Municipality's standards.

#### **DISCUSSION**

The cost sharing component associated with paving and related reinstatement from Sandy Academy Entrance to Smiths Road was estimated. It is anticipated work will commence as the weather permits in the 2017 construction season.

There are no Local Improvement charges associated with this work.

## **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

Based on the Engineering evaluation the estimated cost to HRM is \$200,000 plus net HST of \$8,572, for a net total of \$208,572 (net HST included), funding is available in the Approved 2017/18 Project Budget from Project Account No. CR000005 – Street Recapitalization. 
