Date of Council Meeting: October 4, 2016		
Subject: Reinstatement of Crosswalk near Sheet Harbour Hospital		
Motion for Council to Consider: That Regional Council requests a staff report to determine how the Municipality can make a formal request to the Nova Scotia Department of Transportation to reinstate a pedestrian crosswalk on Highway #7 near the vicinity of the Eastern Shore Memorial Hospital in Sheet Harbour.		
Reason: There was a crosswalk located at this site for many years, and due to construction it was subsequently removed. This is a busy section of highway for pedestrians accessing both the hospital and Lawtons Drug Store. The crosswalk would have to be located a short distance west at the intersection of Martin Lane and the road reserve crosscut, where the curb is already cut and reinstall it at that new location, which is still close proximity to the Hospital and Lawtons. In the interest of public safety, it is important to make a case to the NSDOT that a crosswalk be re-established.
