Subject: Large Vehicle Parking in Residential Neighbourhoods		
<p>Motion for Council to Consider: Request a staff report to analyze possible parking restrictions in residential neighbourhoods for large vehicles which match at least one of the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Taller than 2.2 m (7 feet 3 inches)• Longer than 6.4 m (21 feet)• Heavier than 3,000 kg• Not primarily designed to move people• Seats 10 or more passengers		
<p>Reason: There have been a number of businesses who have numerous large commercial vans and trucks that are taking up the majority of street parking spaces available to residents and little ability to enforce these vehicles to move.</p>		
<p>Outcome Sought: A staff report to come up with a viable solution to prevent businesses from using residential streets as parking for their fleet of vehicles.</p>
