Motion for Council to Consider: That Halifax Regional Council request a staff recommendation report with respect to Administrative Orders 29, Respecting HRM Civic Addressing Policies, Administrative Order 46, the HRM Asset Naming Administrative Order, and By-law C-300, the Civic Addressing By-law, to allow the renaming of Forest Hills Parkway to Sidney Crosby Parkway and that staff be directed to forward the draft amendments for Regional Council consideration no later than July 26, 2016.
