Bladder Cancer Awareness Month May 2016

WHEREAS, bladder cancer is the 5th most common cancer in Canada and an estimated 8,300 Canadians will be diagnosed with the disease this year; and

Bladder Cancer Canada helps bladder cancer patients and their support teams address day-to-day issues of this disease, increases awareness of bladder cancer among the general public and medical community and funds research, which pursues the diagnosis, treatment and elimination of bladder cancer.

Bladder Cancer Awareness among Canadians is at a relatively early stage and there is little public awareness about the symptoms. Early diagnosis and treatment leads to more positive outcomes.
