World Sickle Cell Day June 19, 2018

Whereas, about 5,000 Canadians live with Sickle Cell Disease; and

Whereas, World Sickle Cell Day is a day to promote education and understanding about this multisystem disease; and

THEREFORE, be it resolved that I, Mayor Mike Savage, on behalf of Halifax Regional Council, do hereby proclaim, June 19, 2018 to be World Sickle Cell Day in the Halifax Regional Municipality.
