Subject: Wayfinding Strategy		
Motion for Standing Committee to Consider: The CP&ED standing committee requests a staff report on the current HRM initiatives, programs, and policies that are contributing to an HRM-wide wayfinding strategy. The report shall identify gaps in current approach, assess against other relevant jurisdictions, and identify opportunities to improve the current wayfinding practices in HRM.		
Reason: There is a need to improve how residents and visitors orient themselves geographically within specific neighbourhoods and communities, while at the same time maintaining a sense of cohesiveness within HRM.		
Outcome Sought: To improve navigation for vehicular traffic and pedestrians, and to create more welcoming community through a clear, consistent wayfinding system.
