Subject: Maintain Peak Hour Transit Service in North Beaver Bank		
Motion for Regional Council to Consider:		
THAT Regional Council request a staff report outlining options to: maintain morning and afternoon peak hour transit service from the Beaver Bank Kinsac Community Centre to The Ivy Meadows Assisted Living Facility when new Routes 189 Beaver Bank Express and 89 Beaver Bank are implemented as per the 2020 / 21 <i>Moving Forward Together</i> transit plans.		
Reason:		
The <i>Moving Forward Together</i> plan proposes to remove service from Beaver Bank Road north of Kinsac Road currently serviced by the Route 400 Beaver Bank. Residents have been very vocal about maintaining this service and submitted a petition with 221 signatures during the public consultation portion of the <i>Moving Forward Together</i> planning process.		
The changes outlined in the <i>Moving Forward Together</i> plan for service to Beaver Bank result " <i>in the reclassification of the former Route 400 Beaver Bank as a Local Route (Route 89 Beaver Bank). This is a result of the truncation of the route to eliminate the low ridership segment beyond Kinsac Road. Because the route is almost entirely contained within the UTSB, it is considered a Local Route in this plan, and will have a higher level of service than the former Route 400 Beaver Bank.</i> "		
Although indicated to have a " <i>higher level of service</i> " residents request that peak hour service be maintained for north Beaver Bank.		
Outcome Sought:		
A staff report outlining options for maintaining peak hour transit service from Beaver Bank Kinsac Community Centre to The Ivy Meadows Assisted Living Facility.
