



HRM Policing Services Environmental Scan 2nd Quarter 2018



Total HRM Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences reported in the second quarter of 2018 show an **increase** of +314 reported offences or +5.96% compared to the second quarter of 2017. Drugs for second quarter 2018 show a **decrease** of -26 offences or -9.29% compared to second quarter 2017.

Property offences account for **48%** of the reported Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for **17%** and Criminal Other offences account for **35%**.

Property Crimes

Property crime shows an **increase** of +292 reported offences or +12.26%.

Stolen motor vehicles **decreased** by -1 offences or -1.25%.

Break and Enters **increased** by +49 offences or +22.69%.

Frauds **increased** by +105 offences or +32.31%.

Violent Crimes

Violent crime has experienced an **increase** in the second quarter of 2018 compared to 2017 by +145 offences or a change of +18.61%.

Robberies **increased** by +9 offences or a change of +20%.

Homicides **decreased** by -1 or -33.33% in the second quarter of 2018 compared to the same period in 2017.

Attempted murders **decreased** by -3 offences in the second quarter of 2018 or a change of -37.5%.

Assaults **increased** by +138 offences or a change of +19.41%. Assaults accounted for **92%** of violent crimes in the second quarter of 2018.

Criminal Other

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc.) has **decreased** by -123 or -5.83%.

Prostitution offences **increased** by +1 offence in the second quarter of **2018** or +50%.

Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.

Environmental Scan of 2018 2nd Quarter

Total District Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the second quarter of 2018 show a **decrease** of -85 or -6.94% compared to the second quarter in 2017.

Drugs for the second quarter of 2018 **decreased** by -4 or -5.19% compared to the second quarter of 2017.

In the second quarter Property offences count for 45% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for 18% and Other Criminal Code offences account for 37%.

Second Quarter comparison between 2017 and 2018:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime **increased** by +19 or +3.85%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles **decreased** by -12 or -35.29%.

Break and Enters remained the same at 67.

Fraud incidents **increased** by +23 or +30.26%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent Crime **increased** by +9 or +4.48%.

Robberies **decreased** by -2 or -28.57%.

Homicides **increased** by +1 or +100%.

Attempted Murders **decreased** by -1 or -50%.

Assaults **increased** by +10 or +5.32%.

Assaults accounted for 94% of reported violent crimes in the second quarter of 2018.

Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (i.e. arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting currency etc.)

Offensive Weapons **decreased** by -11 in the second quarter of 2018 or by -55%.

Prostitution offences remained the same at 0 in the second quarter of 2018.




Crimes Against Persons 2nd Quarter Comparison 2017-2018




Crimes Against Property 2nd Quarter Comparison 2017-2018






RCMP Halifax District 2nd Quarter Stats Cole Harbour




RCMP Halifax District 2nd Quarter Stats Lower Sackville




RCMP Halifax District 2nd Quarter Stats Musquodoboit Harbour





April - June 2017/18

Assaults

Assaults Level 1 accounted for 54% of the total Assaults in the 2nd quarter of 2018, the 2nd quarter of 2017 had a result of 59% and experienced a -4.35% **decrease** in 2018 over the same period last year.
