World Alzheimer Day September 21, 2018

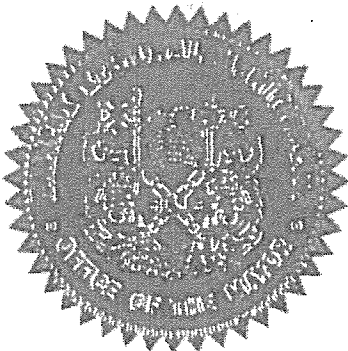
WHEREAS: There are 17,000 Nova Scotians living with Alzheimer's disease and other dementias; and
