THAT Halifax Regional Council:	
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Call on the Federal government to stop its plans to divide maintenance work between the Irving Shipyard in Nova Scotia and Davie Shipbuilding in Quebec, in order to avoid massive job losses and an economic downturn in the region;2. Call on the Federal government to ensure skilled work traditionally done at Irving Shipyard continue to be done there and to support our local workers and their families.	
Reason: There is concern that the federal government plans to move a significant amount of the Halifax-class maintenance and repair work from the Halifax Shipyard to Davie Shipyard in Lévis, Quebec.	
Outcome Sought: Halifax Regional Council supports our Nova Scotia Shipyards and its employees.
