Mr. Mayor,

This year's parades and remembrance of military personnel who served with valour and distinction and gave the ultimate sacrifice in the First World War, the Second World War, the Korean War, in United Nations Peacekeeping missions and most recently in Afghanistan, will occur on Sunday, 11 November 2018. Ceremonies this year will consist of a parade assembling at the Somme Branch Legion and proceeding to Sullivan's Pond in Dartmouth, a parade assembling at the Cole Harbour High School and proceeding to Cole Harbour Place, and a parade assembling at St. Andrews Church in Eastern Passage and proceeding to Caen Legion Branch. These events will include a flypast from a Cyclone helicopter from 12 Wing Shearwater.

It is requested that the Halifax Regional Municipality grant permission for the Canadian Forces to fly a Cyclone helicopter over Sullivan's Pond in Dartmouth at approximately 1108 hours flying North to South, over Cole Harbour Place at approximately 1109 hours flying East to West, and at the Caen Legion Branch #164 on Main Rd Eastern Passage at approximately 1110 hours flying North to South. Requesting flypasts be authorized to fly at a height of 500 feet above the highest obstacle in each location.

The continued support of the Halifax Regional Municipality to this annual remembrance of our shared history is very much appreciated.
