## Environmental Scan of 2018 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter

### Total District Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the third quarter of 2018 show an **increase** of +54 or +4.22% compared to the third quarter in 2017.

Drugs for the third quarter of 2018 **decreased** by -29 or -29.59% compared to the third quarter of 2017.

In the third quarter Property offences count for 47% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for 14% and Criminal Other offences account for 39%.

### **Third Quarter comparison between 2017 and 2018:**

#### Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime **increased** by +57 or +9.97%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles **increased** by +15 or +75%.

Break and Enters **decreased** by -11 or -12.94%.

Fraud incidents **increased** by +99 or +12.50%.

#### Violent Crimes

Overall Violent Crime remained the same at 182 incidents in the third quarter 2018.

Robberies **increased** by +3 or +60%.

Homicides **decreased** by -1 or -50%.

Attempted Murders **decreased** by -1 or -100%.

Assaults **increased** by +1 or +0.59%.

Assaults accounted for 96% of reported violent crimes in the third quarter of 2018.

#### Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (i.e. arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting currency etc.)

Offensive Weapons **increased** by +7 in the third quarter of 2018 or by +33.33%.

Prostitution offences remained the same at 0 in both the third quarter of 2018 and 2017.

#### Assaults

Assaults Level 1 accounted for 64% of the total Assaults in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2018, the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2017 had a result of 57% and experienced a +10% **increase** in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2018 over the same period last year.

Assault with a Weapon Causing Bodily Harm accounted for 11% of the total Assaults in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2018 compared to 15% in 2017 and experienced a -26.92% **decrease** over the same period last year.

All forms of Sexual Assaults combined accounted for 19% of the total Assaults in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2018 compared to 22% in 2017.
