












Economic Impact (Steam Report)

- Combined total of visitor, capital and operational spending as a result of hosting *Maritime Race Weekend* are estimated to total *\$1,308,595*.
- Expenditures are expected to generate a total of **\$2,850,886** of economic activity in the province, of which **\$1,961,915** will be in **Halifax**.
- Estimated to provide a total of 18.5 jobs for Halifax and an additional 4.2 jobs for the remainder of the province jobs will create a total of \$893,240 in wages and salaries.
- The net increase in economic activity in the province as a result of the initial expenditures of the event is \$1.373,778.
- The total level of taxes supported by the 2016 Maritime Race Weekend is estimated at \$577,981. Of this, \$247,828 is allocated to the federal government, \$265,078 to the provincial government and \$65,074 to municipal governments across Nova Scotia.
- The level of municipal taxes supported within Halifax is estimated to be \$53,606.
