## HRM Policing Services Environmental Scan 4th Quarter 2018



### Total HRM Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences reported in the fourth quarter of 2018 show an **increase** of **+60** reported offences or an **increase** of **+1.10%** compared to the fourth quarter of 2017. Drug offences in the fourth quarter of 2018 **decreased** by **-149** or **-55.39%** compared to the fourth quarter of 2017.

Property offences account for **49%** of the reported Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for **15%** and Criminal Other offences account for **36%**.

### Property Crimes

Property crime shows an **increase** of **+74** reported offences or **+2.79%**.

Stolen motor vehicles **decreased** by **-7** offences or **-8.86%**.

Break and Enters **decreased** by **-170** offences or **-45.58%**.

Frauds **increased** by **+153** offences or **+56.88%**.

### Violent Crimes

Violent crime experienced a **decrease** in the fourth quarter of 2018 compared to 2017 by **-50** offences or a change of **5.88%**.

Robberies **decreased** by **-23** offences or a change of **-38.33%**.

Homicides remained the same at **1** in the fourth quarter in 2018 compared to the fourth quarter of 2017.

Attempted murders **decreased** by **-3** or **-75%** in 2018 compared to the fourth quarter of 2017.

Assaults **decreased** by **-17** offences or a change of **-2.22%**. Assaults accounted for **94%** of violent crimes in the fourth quarter of 2018.

### Criminal Other

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc.) has **increased** by **+36** or **+1.83%**.

Prostitution offences **decreased** by **-3** offences in the fourth quarter of 2018 over 2017 or **-100%**.

Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.

Total District Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the fourth quarter of 2018 **decreased** by -85 or by -6.74% compared to the fourth quarter in 2017.

Drugs for the fourth quarter of 2018 **decreased** by -50 or by -58.82% compared to the fourth quarter of 2017.

In the fourth quarter Property offences reported accounted for 47% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons accounted for 17% and Other Criminal Code offences accounted for 36%.

### **Fourth Quarter comparison between 2018 and 2017:**

#### Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime **increased** by +11 or +2.01%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles **decreased** by -13 or -44.83%.

Break and Enters **decreased** by -13 or -15.48%.

Frauds **increased** by +51 or +82.26%.

#### Violent Crimes

Overall Violent Crime **decreased** by -22 or -10%.
