<b>Subject: Improved Visibility for Crosswalk Signage</b>		
<b>Motion for Council to Consider:</b>		
<b>That Halifax Regional Council request the Mayor send a letter to the Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal expressing a desire to amend the regulations under the Motor Vehicle Act (MVA) to add fluorescent yellow-green as a background colour for crosswalk signage to improve visibility and pedestrian safety.</b>		
<b>Reason:</b>		
The regulations for crosswalk signage as outlined in the Nova Scotia Motor Vehicle Act (Section 88) currently allow for a white background colour, except for in school zones, where fluorescent yellow green signs are permitted. The addition of a fluorescent yellow-green background colour for all crosswalk signage will assist in improving overall visibility and enhance pedestrian safety in crosswalks.		
<b>Outcome Sought:</b>		
To request an amendment to the regulations of the Nova Scotia MVA to allow for the addition fluorescent yellow-green as a background colour for all crosswalk signage to improve visibility and pedestrian safety.
