We requested the fly-past from the SkyHawks and we have been given confirmation that they will again be apart of our Opening Ceremonies at Citadel Hill National Historic Site. The fly-past will occur on Monday, July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019, at approximately 12:15 PM. Through this letter I am asking that you, as Mayor acknowledge the fact that the Halifax-Dartmouth Canada Day Committee has made the arrangements for the fly-past and that you understand there is a possibility of the aircraft(s) flying at levels of less than 500 feet.
