Subject: Artisanal Vending, Ferry Terminal Park		
<p>That the Halifax Regional Council request a staff report on amending By-Law C-501 to add Ferry Terminal Park to part C of Schedule B to permit artisanal vending to occur in this location.</p> <p>Reason:</p> <p>Bylaw C-501 allows for artisanal vending (painter, photographer, silversmith, weaver, jeweller, candle maker, leather worker or other artisan) at Nathan Greene Square, Sackville Landing, and Spring Garden Road. A local artist has expressed an interest in acquiring a vending license in Downtown Dartmouth, but there are currently no artisanal vending licenses available beyond the three Downtown Halifax locations. Allowing for artisanal vending would be a low-cost way of placemaking on the Dartmouth waterfront.</p> <p>Outcome Sought:</p> <p>Staff recommendation report</p>
