August 23rd, 2019

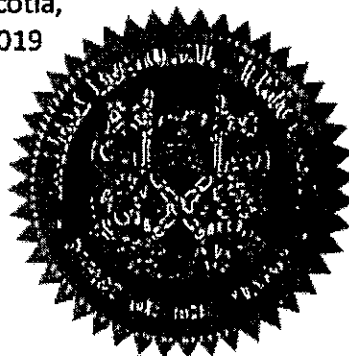
