





- 2017 HRM Public Safety Strategy






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#### PUBLIC SAFETY STRATEGY



- Unanimously adopted by Regional Council: Fall 2017
- Grounded in research from Roundtable Report and Review
- Promotes 'upstream' thinking: focus on a proactive approach to addressing community safety & wellbeing
- Frames a coordinated, collaborative multi-stakeholder approach

- 76 Actions
- Emphasis on where municipality has the authority and capacity to act



BUILD RESIDENT RESILIENCE: Help people to reduce their sense of isolation, build resilience and improve their quality of life.



ENSURE SAFE PLACES: Reduce the opportunities for crime and social disorder at places where people live, work and play.




STRENGTHEN COMMUNITIES: Increase local participation and social interaction, and develop ways to deal with conflict in non-violent ways.
