1989 Native Day Care Dartmouth

Met today with Evelyn Hogan and Charlotte Hazle.

Charlotte is of course well known to me from her previous contacts. She is an employment officer with Canada Employment with particular emphasis for native people. They are requesting assistance with a Native Day Care Centre.

A study is being done by a professor at Mt. St. Vincent which is really a needs assessment. They expect this in a month's time. They feel there is a need for specialized day care for Halifax-Dartmouth native people. The children of young people going to university and an afternoon program for teenagers. It is my understanding that Health and Welfare will be in on this but they are looking for a site, or a house, or some building.

Plan:

- A. Will let Jim Duke have a copy of this. Many of their residences are in the north end and it's possible that the City may have a site which could be given to them for a Day Care Centre.
- B. Ask Jim Duke to discuss this with our Housing List under Don Rix. Perhaps there is some accommodation around that I don't know of.
- C. Possibility of a rental property in Burnside. This is their last alternative but perhaps Julie can be contacted by Jim to look at this.
- I am going to see if Jim can do something with this because it seems to me to be an area which we should be of some help.
