SUBJECT: Active Transportation Advisory Committee Update

October 17, 2019 Meeting

- Jason Beanlands, Active Transportation Planner, made a presentation on monitoring usage of active transportation facilities and the importance of counting to produce the data upon which decisions are based

November 21, 2019 Meeting

- The Committee received a presentation on the Bedford-Sackville Greenway Corridor Project, including an overview of the completed Phases 1 and 2 of the project, the results of the public rounds of engagement and information on next steps
- Leen Romaneh, Transportation Planner, shared a presentation on the Dutch Village Road Complete Streets Project (a 700m section connecting Joseph Howe Drive and Alma Crescent) and the proposed improvements to the road
- Jillian Banfield, Committee Member, put forward a motion recommending that the Transportation Standing Committee request a staff report to look into improvements on Devonshire Avenue for cyclists and pedestrians
