Sir:-

At a meeting of the City Council held on the 14th of July, 1938, a report from the Committee on Works recommending the sale of a piece of land at Africville, being a part of what is known as the Tully property to Mr. B. J. Vaughan, was approved, subsequently at the August meeting a report from the City Solicitor was read in which he gave it as his opinion that the City could not sell the land without receiving Legislative authority therefor. The Council decided to procure legislation to enable the City to sell the land.

Section 28k Chapter 65 of the Acts of 1939 gave the City the right to sell this property for such price as it sees fit.

It would seem to me necessary for the Council, if it still desires to sell the land to Mr. Vaughan to pass a further resolution on the matter.
