

The Special Committee to continue to confer with the Archbishop & to make a formal agreement - & conclude all other final arrangements necessary

The Secy advised to inform his Grace of the decision of the Board

The Supt of Education requests to meet the Board to adjust with them a standard of teaching days for the educational year -

Mr W Teas 2nd Class Teacher appointed to Campbell Road School from 1st of July salary to be \$240

Amendments to Educational Act had been adopted by the Govt. excepting separate School Inspector for the City

Specified by him, and that the same Special Committee continue to confer with his Grace and make a formal agreement, and conclude all other final arrangements that may be deemed necessary with him

The Secretary was instructed to communicate the decision of the Board to the Archbishop immediately -

The Supt. of Education through the Secretary expressed a wish to meet the Board or a committee and to request with them a certain standard of teaching days for the summer and winter educational year for the City of Halifax - referred to Committee on Teachers

The Committee on Teachers reported that they had appointed Mr Teas Second Class Teacher to take charge of the Campbell Road School his appointment to date from June 1st & his salary to be at the same rate paid to Mr Wright Ex Master viz \$240⁰⁰ per Annum - which was approved

The Chairman reported that all of the amendments recommended by the Board to the Educational Act had been adopted by the Government with the exception of the clause relating to the appointment of a separate School Inspector for the City of Halifax
