

The Committee on Teachers reported that they had an interview with the Commissioners of the Poor Asylum - they had agreed to pay to the Board the sum of £50.0.0 in quarterly payments towards the salary of a Second Class Male Teacher - the Board to provide the balance required £25.0.0.

Commissioners of Poor Asylum agree to pay \$200 per annum to the Board for Teacher Salary -

The Committee further reported that the Commissioners of Poor Asylum required that the Board should provide the poor House school with necessary furniture

Require the Board to furnish the poor House school

The Committee recommended that Mr Wm Seas Second Class Teacher be employed at the Poor House School at a salary of £75.0.0 per annum from June 1

Mr Seas appointed Teacher - at \$300 per annum from June 1

also that in consequence of the change of arrangement with Mr Seas.

Miss Dixon to remain at Campbell Road School till summer vacation

Miss Dixon be continued as teacher of the Campbell Road School till the summer vacation at the same rate of salary viz \$160.00 per annum

on Motion all of the above recommendations approved of the Committee on Teachers were approved

on Motion The Committee on School Building were requested to put themselves in communication with the Commissioners of the Poor Asylum relative to fitting up the school - with authority to provide what was necessary
