Minutes of last Meeting read & Confirmed

The Chairman stated that in view of the change contemplated in the educational Act with reference to the City of Halifax - he thought it would be advisable for the Board to confine themselves to business of the more pressing nature leaving more important requirements to be attended to by their successors -

The Committee on teachers reported. They recommend that Miss Catharine Gossip 2nd Class Teacher be appointed assistant teacher of St. Luke's boys' School as substitute for Miss Gammell who had obtained leave of absence from the Board. Miss Gossip appointed to St. Luke's during the absence of Miss Gammell. Which on Motion was received & adopted

They also recommend that Mr. Adler 2nd Class teacher an applicant for the Campbell Road School, should be written to by the Secretary and requested to furnish the Board with testimonials from Hubbard's Cove, where he is now engaged, as to his moral character and capability as a teacher - his City references not being deemed sufficient by the Committee.
