

The new furniture in Yvon school caused marked improvement in order and attention to work. Mr Gosselin's efforts have been successful in bringing pupils into the school but not as yet in keeping them there.

I addressed a meeting of the Colored people last winter whose children this school is intended to accommodate on the importance of sending their children to school and a few days after 60 pupils were in attendance. This increased attendance continued for a time, but the interest soon waned and the school decreased. A year ago however these Colored children could scarcely be got to school at all. Never before the present term did the attendance at school average much over a dozen. During this term the day pupils averaged 34 - and the average attendance at the night school was 35. The pupils of the Campbell Road school have attended pretty well and have made good progress since Mr Brown has had charge.
