Read two petitions: —
One, from the teachers of the High School, the other from the teachers of the Common Schools and the supervisor, praying for the restoration of the ten per cent ^{reduction} made in the salaries under resolution of the Board of October 30, 1879

Referred to the Com^{ee} on Teachers

The secretary reported that Miss Caroline Byers (colored) to whom the Board (on 16 June 1881) granted a subsidy for teaching at Africville, had notified him that owing to failing health she had given up teaching at the end of last month

Referred to the Committee on Teachers

The secretary was instructed, in closing the accounts for the year, not to include in the Septemb^r pay sheet any amount for Mr. F. J. Davidson for August at Morris St School See Report Finance Com 31 Aug p 476.
