Clause 2:- On motion of Commissioner Ingles seconded by Commissioner Walsh the Secretary was instructed to write to the principals of the various schools, call their attention to the defacing and destroying of the property, and request them to exercise such a supervision of their pupils as will prevent a recurrence of the cause of the complaint.

Clauses 2 and 3 were then adopted and the report, on motion of Commissioner Walsh adopted as a whole.

Commissioner Walsh reported verbally that the Committee on School Sites and Buildings had caused to be prepared a plan and specification of the proposed new school house at Africville and had advertised for tenders returnable on Wednesday 22nd inst.

The Secretary reported that Mr. Hodges had sent Aubrey Rounsfell's prize about which enquiry was made at last meeting and read a p.c. acknowledging its receipt.

The following matters on the Order of the Day were laid over until next meeting:- Report of Special Committee on number of Sessions; Protest against the closing of the Coburg Road School; Letter of Henry Russell;

But the Secretary was instructed to notify principals that until further orders the recommendation in the second clause of the report of the Committee on Number of Sessions &c would be in force viz:-
