1. - Tenders having been invited for the construction of a school house at Africville several were received and that of James F. Borston for \$485⁰⁰ was considered the most satisfactory and the contract is recommended to be awarded to him. Application has been made to the Governor in Council for approval, but owing to the unexpected calling away of Hon. Mr. Church on account of the death of his mother, the matter has not been definitely settled but sufficient assurance has been given that the matter will be satisfactorily arranged.

2. - The repairs to Russell St School have been completed in a satisfactory manner and although the cost has gone a small amount beyond the sum specified, it was caused by matters over which the committee had no control, or which could not be foreseen.

3. - It having been brought to the notice of this committee that repairs were required at Brunswick St School demanding immediate attention, your committee undertook the work which is now being proceeded with. Your concurrence is requested.

4. - Mrs. Catherine Weaver is recommended for the position of janitrix of Russell St School.
