Requisitions

1. - The Committee on Teachers recom-  
mend that the requisitions for stationery  
supplies, as amended, be granted.  
2. - They find that the scale of teachers'  
salaries does not fix any rate for Grade D.  
male teachers, and therefore had nothing on  
which to base Mr. Skerrett's salary: They recom-  
mend that he be paid a salary of \$350<sup>00</sup> from  
1st inst with an increase of \$20<sup>00</sup> a year from  
1st Novr 1884 until the salary reach \$450<sup>00</sup> and  
that this be the scale for Grade D males if  
any others should at any time be employed.  
3. - The Committee recommend that Mr.  
Doyle's position as teacher of the 3rd depart-  
ment of St. Patrick's School be declared vacant,  
he having been absent since 6th September  
without leave.
