Halifax N.S. 19 March 1885

The Committee on Teachers make the following recommendations:-

- 1.- That the requisitions for supplies as amended be granted
- 2.- That Mr James A. Smith be transferred from the 11<sup>th</sup> department of Albro St School to Africville School in place of Mr. J. W. Skerrett resigned.
- 3.- That Mr R. Logan be transferred from the 2<sup>nd</sup> department of Maynard St School to the 11<sup>th</sup> department of Albro St School in place of Mr Smith, transferred.
- 4.- That Miss L. B. Shaffer late of the Poor Asylum school (now closed) be appointed to the 2<sup>nd</sup> department of Maynard St School in place of Mr. Logan, transferred.
- 5.- That Miss Janet A. Wileod be transferred from the 6<sup>th</sup> department of Brunswick St School to the 1<sup>st</sup> department of Acadia School as principal. Miss Wileod's transfer to be made at the beginning of the next school term, the others on ~~provision~~ after Mr. Skerrett's retirement.
- 6.- That for this year, the High School be examined on the 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> of May; the two senior departments of Brunswick St School on the 9<sup>th</sup> of July; and the two senior girls' departments of St. Patrick's on the 10<sup>th</sup> of July.
- 7.- That in the Common Schools, in order to avoid the evils of cramming, and to secure constant and uniform progress, there be for this year, no definite periods of examination fixed in advance; but that from time to time, the Board
