Buildings Rented by the Board

On motion of Commr Kelly, Commr Parker was authorized to have the necessary glazing and repair work done at St Mary's Boys' and Girls' Schools.

The Secretary was directed to communicate with His Grace the Archbishop regarding the necessary repairs to buildings rented from the Episcopal Corporation, i.e. St Mary's Boys and Girls' Schools, St Patrick's Boys and Girls Schools and with the Convent of Sacred Heart regarding College St. School stating that if agreeable to them the Board would make the necessary repairs and adjust the cost.

Commr Parker stated that an outlay of say \$100' would put Afrieville School, an outlay of \$7,000' would put Alexandra and \$3,000' would put St. Patrick's Boys' Schools all in temporary repair, these schools being in commission would house fifty two classes a day.

On motion of Commr Crosby and Wood it was resolved to apply to the Board of Control for this amount.
