(\$516,994.16, that being the amount required for the
support and maintenance of the Schools under the charge
of the Board, and in accordance with the Halifax City
Charter, 1931, Section 916 and following.

This amount does not include interest charges on
debentures issued by the City itself, nor an amount to
supplement pensions paid to retired Teachers.
